Exam prep

- At the time of scheduling your appointment, you will be advised how to prepare for the exam.
- Some Abdomen and Pelvic examinations require an oral contrast drink to enhance your digestive tract. You may pick this up at your earliest convenience so you may drink in the comfort of your home as instructed.
- In addition, no solid foods two hours prior to your Chest CT, Abdomen/Pelvis CT exam.
- Please let us know if you are allergic to intravenous CT or MRI contrast
- Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment time to check-in.

Exam Duration

- Most CT patients should plan to spend 30 minutes at our facility. The length of the appointment will depend upon the CT exam your healthcare provider ordered.
- The technologist will help you onto the table, and once you're comfortable the exam will begin.

Results

- Once the exam is completed, a certified Radiologist will review the study and dictate the final report.
- This report will be sent to the healthcare provider who ordered your exam.
- Results are available through the LRGHealthcare patient portal. You may enroll in the patient portal at the time of check-in. Please ask the receptionist for details.
- We recommend you follow up with your healthcare provider to discuss the final results of your examination.
